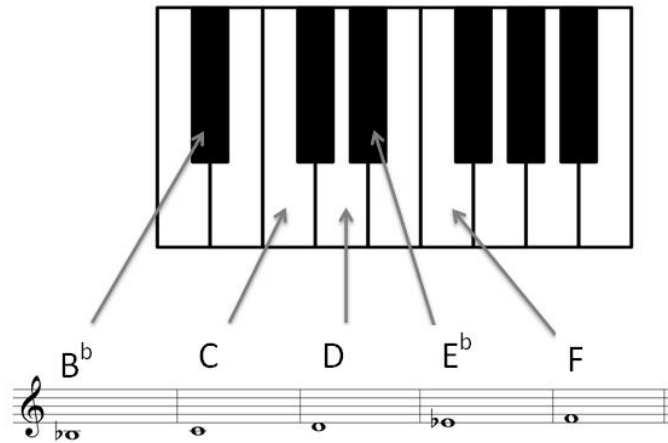


Five Note Songs: Percussion
